Cookies

This website uses so-called “cookies.” These are text files that the server stores on your computer. They contain information on the browser, the IP address, the operating system and on the Internet connection. We do not share this data with third parties or combine it with personal data without your consent.

Cookies primarily perform two functions. They help us make it easier for you to navigate through our offering and enable the website to display properly. They are not used to introduce viruses or to start programs.

It is also possible for users to view our offering without cookies. To this end, corresponding settings must be changed in the browser. Use of Google Analytics

Contract data processing

Facebook plug-ins (like button)

LinkedIn

SSL encryption

Data economy

Your rights to information, correction, blocking, deletion and objection

You have the right, upon request, to ask for free information concerning the personal data that is stored with us and/or to demand a correction, blocking or deletion. Exceptions: when the data storage is required for business purposes or the data is subject to the statutory retention obligation.

In order to be able to consult a data lock at any time, it is necessary to have the data available in a locked file for control purposes. If there is no statutory archiving obligation, you may also require the data to be deleted. Otherwise we will lock the data if you desire this.

Right to complain to the competent supervisory authority

When there is a violation of data protection law, the data subject has a right to complain to the competent supervisory authority. The competent supervisory authority on data protection issues is the regional data protection officer of the federal state in which our company has its registered office.
